Notice is hereby given that the City of Fruitland will hold a General Election for Three (3) seats on the Fruitland City Council on Monday, October 4, 2010. Polling will take place at City Hall, 401 East Main Street, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The seats currently held by Council President Gregory J. Olinde, Councilor Theodore O. Lokey and Councilor Richard F. Tull will be subject to election.

The following Election Schedule has been established for the conduct of the election:

- * Monday, July 5, 2010: Candidates may file Petitions of Candidacy with the members of the Board of Supervisors of Elections or the City Clerk.
- * Monday, September 6, 2010: Deadline for filing Petitions of Candidacy is 5:00 p.m.
- * Monday, September 13, 2010: Deadline to withdraw from Candidacy is 5:00 p.m.
- X Monday, September 13, 2010: Deadline for qualified residents to register to vote in 2010 Fruitland City Council Election is 5:00 p.m.
- * Sunday, September 19, 2010: Notice of Election will be posted in *The Daily Times* and on the City Website at www.cityoffruitland.com.
- * Sunday, October 3, 2010: Sample ballot will be published in *The Daily Times* and on the City Website at www.cityoffruitland.com.
- * Monday, October 4, 2010: Election Day. 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at City Hall.
- * Tuesday, October 12, 2010: Newly elected Councilors will be inducted into Office by the City Clerk.
