

The Fruitland City Council met in Virtual Session on Tuesday, December 8, 2020 at 7:05 p.m. with the following members present:

*President Darlene Kerr, Treasurer Ray Carey, Councilor R. Lee Outen and Councilor Mike Hammond.*

At 7:05 p.m. President Kerr called the Virtual Council meeting to order. Council President Kerr provided an update concerning the Covid 19 protocol implemented at city hall. She stated that city hall was currently closed, but should reopen soon (Wednesday, December 9<sup>th</sup>).

President Kerr acknowledged receipt of the minutes of the Regular Meeting of November 10, 2020 and called for additions or corrections. As there were none, **Councilor Outen moved to adopt the minutes as presented; Treasurer Carey seconded, and the motion passed on a vote of four to zero.**

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

1. **Paid Bills**

President Kerr acknowledged receipt of the paid bill report. **On a motion made by Treasurer Carey and seconded by Councilor Outen the paid bills were approved by a vote of four to zero.**

#### **PUBLIC HEARING – Sanitation Ordinance # 301**

At 7:10 p.m. City Solicitor Mitchell read the title and provided a briefing on the new sanitation ordinance and then advised the Council that, due the special circumstances surrounding December's city council meeting, they could vote to have the public hearing for Sanitation Ordinance No. 301 rescheduled for January 12, 2021 and that no readvertising would be required prior to the hearing.

**Councilor Outen made a motion to reschedule the public hearing Sanitation Ordinance # 301, Councilor Hammond seconded, and the motion was approved by a vote of four to zero.**

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

No new business was discussed due to the streamlined agenda.

#### **Public Comment/General Discussion**

While the streamlined agenda did not address a public comment/general discussion period, there were guests (2) who were listening to the teleconference meeting. That being the case, the Council asked if they

had any questions or comments. Ms. Tracey Duquette stated that since the public hearing for the sanitation ordinance was going to be rescheduled for January 12<sup>th</sup>, she would withhold her comments until such time.
